THE POSITION: INSTRUMENTATION TECHNICIAN

The incumbent will report to the **Supervisor: Instrumentation** and will be accountable for:

ROLE ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- Use diagnostic programs for the troubleshooting of instruments.
