## THE POSITION: SKILLS DEVELOPMENT FACILITATOR

The incumbent will report to the **Manager: Organisational Development & Effectiveness** and will be accountable for:

### **ROLE ACCOUNTABILITIES:**

- Legal, Safety, Health and Environmental Compliance as well as promoting a safety culture in the area of responsibility.
- Lead by example through compliance with the company purpose and values.
- Develop training matrices to determine training needs in the production areas.
- Engage line management to identify skill gaps.
- Design and review training material to address training needs.
- Design assessment tools in compliance with relevant legislation, company standards and policies.
- Maintain established training schedule.
- Plan, coordinate and facilitate theory and practical training sessions.
- Conduct training assessments and evaluations to determine the competency of employees through theoretical and/or practical assessments.
- Support employees by providing one-on-one coaching after assessment to manage learning experience.
- Schedule and facilitate Dover testing and interpret Dover test results.
- Complete all course administration tasks, i.e. update training matrices, create individual files, name tags, and ensure safe keeping of all training records.
